Daide Tura (1986) works as a pianist, composer and conductor.

He is founder and director of the **Virgilio Ensemble** and of the **Einstein YouthOrcheStar**, artistic director of the **Suono DiVino music festival in Sogliano al Rubicone**. He receives commissions from ensembles, concert performers and private individuals. As an interpreter and composer he recorded CD and performed in Sweden, France, Austria, Hungary and Italy.

Artistic Curriculum-Short Form

Daide Tura is a pianist and composer from Rimini in Italy. In 2007 he obtained a **degree in pianoforte with maximum grades** at the "G.Frescobaldi" Academy of Music in Ferrara, studying privately. In 2010 he received the **diploma after a Two-year Teacher Training** course in state schools which have a music department at the "G.Rossini" Academy of Music in Pesaro.

In 2013 he attended the last semester in **Master at Liszt Ferenc Academy of Music in Budapest** with Maestro Gabor Eckhardt and Klara Kormendi, he is also focused on a paper on Bartók's music thanks a scholarship from "A.Boito" Conservatory of Music in Parma where he concluded in July 2013 a two- year course of pianoforte receiving **110 and Praise with Maestro Roberto Cappello**. In 2015 Davide attended the **Degree in Chamber Music** at the Conservatory "A. Boito" of Parma with Maestro Maurizzi.

He performs as a classical solo pianist in various **international locations**: Budapest, Vanesborg (Goteborg), Pontoise (Paris), Strasbourg, Oslip (Wien); as a busker in Stuggard, Mainz, Berlin, Munich. Nationwide always receiving high appreciation: for the cities of Napoli, Milano, Brescia, Alessandria, Bari, Rimini, Pesaro, Florence, Rome, Chieti, Aquila, Varese, Treviso. His repertoire is comprised of both classic and modern composers, from Bach (1685) to Ginastera (1916) and also his compositions.

As a Composer, his septet "Fragments" was played by National Austrian Radio ORF and also in the Venice's Theatre "La Fenice". He plays in the Piano Duo with the Maestro Francesca Cesaretti and in Duo with the French Violinist Caroline Drouin.

He is enrolled in the **Master's in Applied Music to Images** at the Conservatory of Rovigo.

In October 2020 a **new CD** is released for the **Amadeus Arte label** entitled S (ottrazioni) composed of original music for Piano Solo.

He is teacher in Rimini, where he organizes events, lessons and other musical activities since 2009.
