

KAMERA FILM - Film production company Kamera Film is a film production company. In his decades of experience, he has produced fiction, documentaries and series, which have obtained prizes and recognition, building for each project its specific narrative and its specific cultural, social and artistic value. Producer and director Maria Martinelli, author of documentaries, with particular attention to the narration of different female profiles; she founded with Franco Calandrini and Stefano Mordini in Ravenna, the cultural cooperative Start Cinema from which the Ravenna Nightmare Film Fest XXII and Visioni Fantastiche Cinema per la Scuola III film festivals were born. In 2000 you founded the production company Kamera Film.

Present in major Italian and European film festivals, including: Torino Film Festival; Venice International Film Festival; 55th Berlin Film Festival - International Film Competition; and internationals such as Tokyo Film Festival, Haifa International Film Festival, Buenos Aires Film Festival, Philadelphia Film Festival, where it has obtained awards and prizes, has always been engaged in the research and development of "narrative genres", collaborating with the most significant professionals of national and international independent cinema. Among his titles Faber, doc / portrait on Fabrizio de Andrè and Paz77 a journey with Andrea Paziienza directed by Stefano Mordini; Gladiators, reportage on Italian hard cinema and Carne da Macello, doc investigation taken from the book Fast Food Nation in collaboration with Maria Martinelli's weekly magazine Internazionale; Provincia Meccanica, by Stefano Mordini, a fictional feature film starring Stefano Accorsi and Valentina Cervi, the only Italian film in competition at the 55th Berlin Film Festival, three nominations for the David di Donatello and two for the Silver Ribbons. Always oriented towards the creation of models both from an artistic and a productive point of view, it has always dealt with new and old media, from cinema to television up to the network. Engaged in the research and development of "narrative genres", in 2006 she produced the 6-part docufiction L'Amore che Fugge broadcast on Foxlife and presented at the Bellaria Film Festival Anteprimadoc, where she won the Vela d'Argento. In 2007 she made the documentary film Il Confine, on the Italian Islamic reality in collaboration with Dolmen Mikado, and Io Giuro - Appunti di Donne Soldato, a documentary in two episodes for Doc3 broadcast in October 2007 on Rai3. In 2009 it was the turn of the documentary Over the Rainbow, present in cinemas and scheduled in June 2009 on Doc3, a documentary program on Rai3, a story that tells of the conflicts of two women who love each other and want to have a child. The documentary is screened in the Senate on May 26, following an interpellation that sees it at the center of the debate on homogeneity. In 2010 she made La Colpa, a fictional short film produced and broadcast on Rai2. In 2011 she made with the writer Vincenzo Vassile the documentary on the racket Journey into the World of Extortion - Chapter I The Antiracket, distributed in the cinemas of the Emilia Romagna Region for the Doc in tour project.

In 2013, funding from the Emilia Romagna Region Film Commission for the project allowed the creation of the Portuali documentary, while in 2015 on TV2000 the documentary Route 2014_Strade di Coraggio produced in collaboration with the Ass. Agesci. In 2016 the co-production with Ravenna Teatro - Teatro delle Albe for the feature film Vita arrested by Aung San Suu Kyi written and directed by Marco Martinelli and in international preview at the Biograf Film Fest 2017. In 2017 also the spot For our Figli, directed by Stefano Mordini, created for the promotional campaign of the San

Patrignano Community. In 2016 she produced the doc miniseries in two episodes "The Artist is Innocent / Save the Artist" with the contribution of the Film Commission Region E-R, broadcast on TRCTV and now on Amazon Prime Direct. In 2017 he obtained the Development Support from the Emilia Romagna Film Commission for the feature film Gli Amanti - Rain Falls in production - 2022. In 2018 with the short documentary Dem Dikk Africa - Africa round trip, by Maria Martinelli, Moussa Ndiaye, Alessandro Argnani, directed by Maria Martinelli, he won the MigrArti Cinema tender of the MiBact and won the contribution of the Film Commission of the Emilia-Romagna Region. Selected at the VPB Market Screenings / 75th International Film Festival La Biennale di Venezia. Produced in collaboration with Ass. Takku Ligey Ravenna, Kër Théâtre Mandiaye N'Diaye, Ravenna Teatro - Teatro delle Albe, Start Cinema. In 2020/2021, with the contribution of the Emilia Romagna Film Commission, the support of the social cooperative SoLco is in production, a crowdfunding that exceeds the pre-established threshold and the support of the Italian Federation of homeless people fio.PSD for the distribution in more than 35 cities of Italy the docu film The Passengers directed by Tommaso Valente and Christian Poli on the theme of Housing First which remains in the segment of the narrative of the real and the social. In 2021 he produced, with the support of the Emilia Romagna Film Commission and the Ass. Noi Giovani, the short film La Cava by the young Imola director Gian Marco Pezzoli, the screenplay by two young professionals, Marta Bedeschi and Giorgia Baracco. In 2022, production begins on the film Redemption by Maria Martinelli produced by Kamera Film with the support of the Emilia-Romagna Region, through the Emilia-Romagna Film Commission which, after the Official Selection at the 40th Torino Film Festival, won a new Official nomination Selection in the Arthouse section of the WRPN Women's International Film Festival in Delaware, U.S. and subsequently an Exceptional Merit. The film will be released in national cinemas in spring 2023. Screening 8 July 2023 at the iDEA Cinema Festival in Rome. Last prestigious selection at the Official Selection Toronto Arthouse Film Festival 2023.
