Francesco Cavalli is a founders of both the Ilaria Alpi & Morrione Journalism Awards. Director of the Hic Sunt Leones Association.

In 1987, when he was just eighteen, he joined the reality of Comunità Aperta and then Radio Icaro - of which he is today the managing director - one of the main communication networks of Rimini.

In 2006 he took part in the reportage: "Somalia-Italy on the traffic of toxic waste in Somalia". The journalistic work will be subsequently acquired in the records by the parliamentary commission of inquiry into the waste cycle and by the Parliamentary Commission of inquiry into the death of Ilaria Alpi and Miran Hrovatin (ilariaalpi.it; premioilariaalpi.it).

In the years 2001-2009 he is Councillor for Culture of the Municipality of Riccione. Francesco is vice president of the National Coordination of local authorities for peace and human rights and has collaborated in the realization of the last Perugia-Assisi peace marches, including that of 2012 in Palestine.

Since 2007 he travels regularly to Africa to continue the investigations into the events related to Ilaria Alpi or, on behalf of the NGO Amani, of which he is vice-president, a lay association that supports projects in Kenya, Zambia and Sudan.
